OCTOBER P&C MEETING SUMMARY

The October meeting was well attended and there was lots of lively discussion. There are some updates to share:

DISCUSSIONS ON FUNDING:

1:1 Devices - Replacement Program - Dan Sprange presented some initial modelling of projected costs, based on a 7 year life cycle, for maintaining current and purchasing future devices so that the school is able to continue to provide one to one devices for students. A discussion followed where it was proposed that the costs be shared between the P&C, the school and enrolled families. The anticipated annual cost is more than the P&C can sustain despite our best fundraising efforts! More information on this program will be communicated in due course and parents are welcome to participate in discussion sessions with the school and P&C when they are scheduled.

School Spectacular Co Funding of Excursion - Schools Spectacular is a iconic cultural event incorporating students from diverse backgrounds and communities of NSW. With over 5000 performers this year, which includes a small number of RLPS students, the school is coordinating a whole school excursion to the show which is titled 'Creating the Magic'. The P&C will help fund some of the cost of the excursion and will provide a subsidy of \$15 per student. Families will be asked to contribute the balance. It will be an amazing day out for the students at Qudos Arena on Friday 25th November.
